Students Eligible for Free and Reduced-Price Meals (FARMS)
Eligibility as of October 31, 2025

Definitions

Community Eligibility Provision (CEP): A federal provision, allowing schools and local educational agencies (LEAs) located in low-income areas to provide free breakfast and lunch to all students. CEP eliminates the burden of collecting household Free And Reduced-price Meal (FARMS) applications to determine eligibility for school meal programs. MCPS adopted CEP in 60 schools for the 2025-26 school year. MCPS no longer collects FARMS applications from households in CEP schools.

Actual FARMS Total: The total number of students enrolled in a school that qualify for free and reduced-price meals. This number is inclusive of students who qualify via Direct Certification based on other means tested programs (SNAP, TANF, Medicaid Free, Foster, Migrant, Runaway, Homeless), and those who qualify based on a FARMS income application. Note that since CEP schools do not collect FARMS applications, this number will not be inclusive of all students who may qualify for FARMS.

Effective FARMS Total: Effective FARMS Totals are calculated for schools participating in CEP because DFNS no longer collects student level data via FARMS applications. The Effective FARMS Total is the *estimated* number of students enrolled in a school that qualify for free and reduced-price meals. This number is calculated by multiplying the number of students who qualify for free meals via Direct Certification based on other means tested programs (SNAP, TANF, Medicaid Free, Foster, Migrant, Runaway, Homeless) by the USDA approved 1.6 multiplier. 1.6 is used as an approved estimate of how many additional students would qualify for FARMS if income based applications were utilized.

Effective FARMS Rate: In non-CEP schools, this is the percent of student who qualify for FARMS. In CEP schools, this is the estimated percent of students who qualify for FARMS (even though all students at the school are able to receive free meal benefits). This number is calculated by multiplying the number of students who qualify for free meals via Direct Certification based on other means tested programs (SNAP, TANF, Medicaid Free, Foster, Migrant, Runaway, Homeless) by the USDA approved 1.6 multiplier. 1.6 is used as an approved estimate of how many additional students would qualify for FARMS if income based applications were utilized.
