

Hints to Help with Math at Home

Have your child explain how they are figuring out the answers to Math problems.

Take an interest in what your child is learning in Math.

Have a positive attitude with respect to the ability of your child to achieve success.

Help your child learn their basic math facts in a relaxed manner.
(Ex. Make it a game)

Share experiences at home and in the environment that involve Math.

- Measuring when cooking
- Counting money at the store
- Estimate the cost of a grocery order
- Telling time for beginning and ending time of an activity
- Identify shapes you see as you are driving

Do some Math activities with your child.

- Count objects around the house, such as the number of forks or spoons needed for dinner and then multiply that by the number of people eating dinner
- Use dominoes or playing cards to help build basic fact skills
- Find different combinations of coins for fifty cents
- Keep track of your child's height throughout the year

Encourage your child to use a variety of strategies to solve problems.
