- Be on time on the day of testing Students who arrive at school late will not be allowed into the classroom during a testing session and will be required to test on a make-up day.
- NO CELL PHONES/WATCHES/Bluetooth Headphones Personal mobile devices, such as cell phones/watches/tablets or Bluetooth-enabled headphones, are NOT permitted during the assessment administration. Use of these items during testing is a violation of test security and is strictly prohibited.
