CKLA/DIBELS Resource	Grade Level	Description
CKLA Boost	K-5	Boost Reading is a literacy acceleration and remediation program based on the Science of Reading that uses adaptive technology to deliver personalized learning instruction for K–5 students. Boost Reading resources will be available until the end of June 2025. Students login through their individual student accounts.
DIBELS Home Connect Activities	K-5	DIBELS Home Connect Activities are short, engaging resources sent home to help families support their child’s reading development. These activities are based on a student’s performance on mCLASS DIBELS assessments and are designed to target specific foundational reading skills like phonemic awareness, phonics, and fluency. They are simple, easy-to-use, and align with classroom instruction so families can reinforce learning at home in meaningful, manageable ways. English español (clic en español)
Shared Student Hub Logins	K-5	Amplify CKLA Shared Student Login by Grade. The Amplify CKLA Student Hub is a digital platform designed to enhance the learning experience for students in grades K–5 participating in the Amplify Core Knowledge Language Arts (CKLA) program. Getting Ready For Kindergarten	PreK	These activities were created to support reading at home to get your child ready for Kindergarten. English español 中文 français português 한국어 tiếng Việt አማርኛ
FCRR	PreK-5	A team of researchers and teachers at FCRR collected ideas and created Student Center Activities for use in pre-kindergarten through fifth-grade students. The activities are designed for students to practice, demonstrate, and extend their learning of what has already been taught, sometimes with teacher assistance and sometimes independently. Students can complete the activities in small groups, pairs, or individually.
Starfall	PreK-5	Starfall activities are research-based and align with state learning objectives for English Language Arts. Its emphasis on phonemic awareness, systematic sequential phonics, and common sight words in conjunction with audiovisual interactivity is especially effective for teaching emergent readers, children of all ages with special needs or learning difficulties, as well as EMLs.

Tumblebooks	K-8	All levels can access this resource. The resource includes picture books, read along chapter books, graphic novels, novels, and titles in Spanish and a few in French.
SORA	K-5	This is an ebook/audio book platform. There are over 1000 ebooks in the central collection. Please access the How to use SORA to learn how to use the SORA app to listen to/read ebooks.
Epic	K-8	Boost confidence with real books students love. Access thousands of digital books, loved by millions of kids in grades 8 and under.
GALE	K-5	Gale In Context is a kid-friendly website that helps students learn and research (i.e., science, history, or current events) using trusted articles, videos, and images—all matched to their grade level.
Story time From Space	K-5	Story Time From Space is an educational program where astronauts aboard the International Space Station (ISS) read children’s books aloud on video while floating in microgravity. The videos are recorded and made available online to help engage students in literacy and science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) learning.
Britannica School	K-5	This site has excellent nonfiction articles aimed at students in grades 2-5. There are biographies, Animal Kingdom, and other general interest articles. Within this service is “Fundamentals,” which is geared to the PreK-2 audience. There is also a Spanish equivalent linked within the site.
Factcite 123	2-5	There are non-fiction articles aimed at students in grades 2-5, which include science, social studies, biographies, and SEL topics.
Factcite Lingo 123	2-5	Replicates 123, but has a built-in tool to translate paragraphs into Spanish (authentic Spanish translations)

Open Source Phonics	3-5	Phonics resource specifically designed to help students and families practice phonics and spelling at home.
National Geographic Kids Magazine	K-5	National Geographic Kids provides magazines, videos, and photos about adventures in science, nature, culture, archaeology, and space.
Capstone Interactive eBooks	K-5	Capstone Interactive Library is a collection of eBooks about different subjects, genres, and levels to find just the right book. Audio recorded by professional voice-over artists supports every title. Each school has its own collection.
