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Math Focus

This month, we will begin the final module of 3rd grade that offers students intensive practice with word problems, as well as, hands-on investigation experiences with geometry and perimeter. We begin with practicing one and two step word problems. Then, we begin geometry where we will explore the attributes of quadrilaterals and classify examples into various categories.

Reading and Writing Focus

We will be working through Unit 10. Students will learn how the climate, geography, and motivations of the settlers influenced life in each of the 13 colonies. They will also learn about the events that led to the signing of the Declaration of Independence, the Revolutionary War, and the establishment of the United States as an independent nation.

Students will explore narrative writing. They will focus on the characteristics of narratives and will work to apply them in their own writing. They will have the chance to plan, draft, revise, edit, and publish their own narrative as well.

Science and Social Studies Focus

In Module 1, students will learn about budgets and how they help people plan for what they need and want to meet their goals. They also will learn how people make financial decisions to meet their goals. In Module 2, students will learn about how businesses use budgets and make financial decisions to plan for expenses and income to make a profit. They also will learn how businesses use natural, human, and capital resources to provide goods and services.
