



















To participate, students must READ or HAVE READ TO THEM **a minimum of 8** of the 15 picture books nominated. Based on the premise that picture books are for everybody, there are no grade level restrictions.

To participate in Grades 4 through 6, students must READ or HAVE READ TO THEM **a** minimum of three of the nominated chapter books AND/OR **a minimum of three** of the graphic novel books.

Older students may read from early in the school year until voting time; younger students do best if reading is done the last few months before voting.

Each child will have one vote in each of the categories. The media specialist will make arrangements for voting in the spring.

Forms can be completed and emailed to BES@maslmd.org by April 25, 2017.

Schools can choose to **vote online** by participating in the Online Voting for Black-Eyed Susan Nominees. Votes for Picture Books, Grades 4-6, and Graphic Novels are tallied on separate voting surveys. Interested schools should contact **Brittany Tignor** at bdhulme-tignor@mail.worcester.k12.md.us and provide a contact person who would receive email updates, the name of the school, county/LEA, and in which surveys the school would like to be included. Online voting dates for 2017 are January 3rd – April 25th.




