MATH

Eureka Math -Same curriculum used in Grades K-5

Module 1-Counting to 5

Matching objects, sorting, answering “How many?” questions up to 5, Matching numerals to sets of objects up to 5, counting from 5 to 1, and demonstrating concept of “1 more”

Module 2-Shapes

*2-D and 3-D shapes, naming, describing and constructing

Module 3-Counting to 10

*answering “How many?” up to 10, matching numerals to sets up to 10

Module 4-Measurement

Length, weight, volume, first and last, Are there enough? Comparing 2 sets of objects up to 5

Module 5-Addition and subtraction stories and counting to 20

*Writing numerals, contextualizing and decontextualizing addition and subtraction stories using fingers, objects and drawings



READING

Core Knowledge Language Arts- CKLA same curriculum as K-5

Domain Topics:

- 1 All About Me
2. Families and Communities
3. Animals
4. Plants
5. Habitats

Focus on Oral Language, Phonemic Awareness and Phonics, writing to express ideas vs handwriting, letter identification

How to Help at Home

Read to your child

Practice extending speech and language (i.e model talking in a sentence)

Practice dressing and undressing, cleaning up toys and hand-washing at home

Attending Storytime at Local Library
