

# What will First Graders be learning in September?



## Reading/Language Arts

Students will:

- ❖ Retell stories, including key details.
- ❖ Describe characters, setting, and major events in a story using key details.



## Writing

Students will:

- ❖ Create a topic list and choose a topic to write a narrative, including 2 or more sequenced events. Include drawings that demonstrate character's thoughts and feelings.
- ❖ Demonstrate the ability to use proper end punctuation.



## Math


Students will:

- ❖ Count by 1s and 10s to 120 (including one more and one less).
- ❖ Read and write numerals to 120.
- ❖ Understand that the 2 digits of a 2-digit number represent amounts of tens and ones.
- ❖ Compare 2-digit numbers based on the meanings of the tens and ones digits and use  $>$ ,  $<$ , or  $=$  to record the comparisons.
- ❖ Given a 2-digit number, mentally find 10 more or 10 less than the number, without having to count, explain the reasoning used.



## Social Studies and Science

- ❖ In *Social Studies*, students will be able to explain how ground rules promote fairness, responsibility and privacy. They will also be able to identify home, school and community responsibilities.
- ❖ In *Science*, students will study the basic needs of plants and animals in our environment.
