## Walter Johnson High School Student Parking Agreement

**Parking is a privilege.** It is the student's responsibility to adhere to the school's discipline policy and listed parking regulations. Permits must be displayed hanging from the rear view mirror facing outward for easy viewing. Permits are assigned to specific vehicles for each semester and may not be shared between students. Any changes must be reported to the Security Office.

**Priorities for issuance of permits:** Because there are a limited number of parking spaces that are available, it has become necessary to create a priority list for issuance of permits for those spaces. A priority list has been developed and is outlined in the Montgomery County Public Schools Regulations and Policies Manual (ECG-RA). In compliance with those guidelines that list is contained below.

- 1. Students who are seniors
- 2. Students with disabilities
- 3. Students in school work programs
- 4. Students attending other learning centers
- 5. Students with part time school schedules
- 6. Participation in after school activities

## **Prohibited activities:**

- 1. Arriving unexcused tardy to school
- 2. Violations of traffic/ criminal code
- 3. Parking in more than one space
- 4. Parking in staff or visitors lot
- 5. Allowing unauthorized use of parking permit

Consequences for violation of the Parking Agreement: This will serve as your only warning that action will be taken for violations of the Parking Agreement. The consequences will be applied as appropriate. The operator/ owner will be responsible for all ticket fees, fines, and tow fees.
